

PSA SCRIPT 1: PERSONAL SAFETY

Background Music:

G: “We’ve all heard those parental warnings; ‘Don’t take rides from strangers’, ‘Wear a jacket, you’ll get sick’ but there’s a new danger that nobody’s talking about {insert clown horn}. The streets of our small towns are beginning to become less and less safe for us, and our children. Why isn’t this being discussed?”

L: “Alright bye guys, I’ll see you tomorrow at school! It’s so chilly and dark out, falls really setting in! Glad I’ve got a long walk home alone to think to myself!”

G: “This is NOT what we want to be hearing as parents, and as children/teenagers. PSA SCRIPT 2: SAFE SEX/STD TESTING

Background Music:

A: “What’d you bring for show and tell today?”

L: “I brought a toy racecar!”

A: “I brought my piggy bank!”

C:{pill bottle rattles} “I brought my dad’s gonorrhoea medicine!”

D: “oh, why don’t we put that away for now?”

C: “you said to bring something the somebody in my family uses every day?”

G: “Would you want to be the parent of this child? Having to face the teacher and other parents to discuss this issue? There’s an easier way of avoiding situations like these, ‘don’t have kids?’ you might be asking, and {chuckle chuckle} yes that is one way. Your better option is to always make sure to practice safe sex every time. Use birth control and infection blocking strategies every time. If you are sexually active, make sure to see your doctor regularly, book an appointment to be tested. Early detection is key. Next time someone says ‘would you like a bag with that?’ take the question a bit more literally.”
