How important was that text? Was it worth her life? In 2014 3,179 people were killed and 431,000 people wounded in a motor vehicle crash involving distracted drivers. Ten percent of drivers aged 15 to 19 who were involved in fatal automobile accidents were reported as distracted at the time of the crashes. Approximately 660,000 drivers are using cellphones while driving. Is that one text worth putting your life and other people lives in danger? Stop the text. Stop the wrecks. Drinking and driving

Drinking and driving is one of the main reasons for motor vehicle collisions. One out of every three traffic deaths involve drunk driving. In 2014 every 53 minutes on average, someone is killed in a drunk driving crash and in 2015 it only took 51 min. Is it worth driving when you're under the influence? Is it worth getting caught and having your license taken away? Or worse is it worth putting your life in danger? Is it worth putting others in danger? Is it worth having people you care about upset?
